Flowering Trees for Southwest Idaho

Birdcherry, Summer Glow (*Prunus padus* 'Summer Glow')-upright growth habit. Reddish-purple leaves through the summer. Fragrant white flowers with 1/4" berries. Attractive to birds and wildlife. Prefers full sun. Height 40-50' Spread 20-30' (zone 3-7)

Cherry, Accolade (*Prunus* 'Accolade')-Horizontal spreading branches. Semi-double, 1 1/2" early, pink blossoms in large drooping clusters before the leaves appear. Hardy. Good street tree. Fruitless cultivar. Height & Spread 20-25' (zone 4-8)

Cherry, Kwanzan (*Prunus* 'Kwanzan')-upright, spreading vase shape form. Double, deep rose-pink blooms, 1 1/2-2" in diameter. Mid-season bloomer. New foliage is bronzy and turns to orange-bronze in fall. Height & Spread 15-20' (zone 5-8)

Cherry, Snow Fountain Weeping (*Prunus* 'Snofozam')-Semi-double snow white flowers. Graceful cascading branches. Orange fall color. Heat and drought tolerant. Smaller than other weeping cherries making it ideal for small or Japanese gardens. Height & Spread 12-15' (zone 5-8)

Chokecherry, Canada Red Select (*Prunus virginiana* 'Canada Red Select')-Small tree with pyramidal rounded form. New green foliage turn dark maroon as leaves mature. Long clusters of small, white flowers in late April to early May. Edible 1/4" fruit is red turning to dark purple. Tolerates clay and high pH. Height 25' Spread 20' (zone 2-8)

Crabapple, Bechtal Klehm's Improved (*Malus* 'Bechtal')-Round form, dense green foliage. Large double pink blooms. Orange to orange-red fall color. Seldom fruits, inconspicuous. Height & Spread 15-20' (zone 4-8)

Crabapple, Centurion (*Malus* 'Centzam')-upright open branching. Red buds with single rose-red blooms. Lustrous dark green foliage with slight overcast of red. Rust-orange fall color. Bright 5/8" cherry-red fruit. Excellent disease resistance. Height 20-25' Spread 15' (zone 4-8)

Crabapple, Coralburst (*Malus* 'Coralcole')-Compact rounded dense form. Fairly slow growing. Late season, coral pink buds open to double rose-pink blooms. Bronze 1/2" fruit. Small green leaves. Very good disease resistance. Height & Spread 8-10' (zone 3-8)

Crabapple, Lollipop (*Malus 'Lollizam'*)-Rounded form as the name suggests. Dwarf, compact head with dense foliage. Maintains its symmetrical form without pruning. Prolific white blooms turn to 3/4" golden-amber fruits. Disease resistant. Height & Spread 10' (zone 4)

Crabapple, Prairiefire (*Malus 'Prairiefire'*)-upright, spreading rounded form. Single coral-red blooms, late season. Persistent dark, purple-red, firm, 3/8-1/2" fruit. Emerging red-tinged green foliage. Excellent disease resistant. Height & Spread 15-20' (zone 4-8)

Crabapple, Profusion (*Malus 'Profusion'*)-upright, rounded form. Deep red buds, opening purplish-red fading to purple pink single flowers. Fragrant. Good disease resistance. Maroon-red 1/2" fruit. Purple-bronze leaves. Fast growing. Height & Spread 15-20' (zone 4-8)

Crabapple, Snowdrift (*Malus 'Snodrift'*)-upright, spreading, broad form. Pink buds opening to single white flowers. Long bloom periods. Persistent, salmon-red 3/8" fruit. Heavy textured glossy green foliage. Height & Spread 15-20' (zone 3-8)

Crabapple, Springsnow (*Malus 'Springsnow'*)-upright, oval form. Sugary-white fragrant blooms. Bright green foliage. Yellow bark and yellow fall color. Nearly sterile. Good tree for patio or courtyard. Also available in multi-stem form. Height 20-25' Spread 15-20' (zone 4-8)

Goldenrain Tree (*Koeleretaria paniculata*)-Dense, smaller tree with rounded form. Summer blooming showy, fragrant, yellow flower panicles turn to attractive, reddish-pink, leathery fruit capsules. Excellent as a small lawn tree. Very adaptable to soil extremes. Drought tolerant. Also available in multi-stem form. Height 30-40' spread 20-25' (zone 4-8)

Hawthorn, Thornless Cockspur (*Crataegus crusgalli inermis*)-Rounded to wide-spread form. Vigorous, attractive small tree. Dark green leaves bronze to purple-red in fall. Single, fragrant, white blooms in May. Persistent red fruit attract wildlife. Tolerated hot, dry, salty conditions. Full sun. Height 15-20' Spread 10-15' (zone 4-7)

Hawthorn, Washington (*Crataegus phaenopyrum*)-Rounded upright form with 20-25' spread. Fall color orange to scarlet. White flower clusters appear in May. Small 1/4" glossy red fruit clusters persist all winter. Very adaptable. 1/2" long thorns. Full sun. Height 20-25' Spread 20-25' (zone 4-8)

European Mountain Ash, Cardinal Royal (*Sorbus aucuparia*)-A straight growing trunk and uniform upright branching habit characterize this cultivar. Late spring white blooms turn to 1/4" red fruit. Leaves are dark on top with a silvery underside, turning to orange red in autumn. Needs good drainage. Height 30-40' Spread 15-20' (zone 2-8)

Pear, Aristocrat (*Pyrus calleryana 'Aristocrat'*)-Pyramidal open form. White flowers. Young leaves are reddish tinged maturing to a dark green. Good lateral branching angles make it more resistant to storm damage. Thornless and vigorous. Height 30-35' Spread 20-30' (zone 5-8)

Pear, Cleveland Select (*Pyrus calleryana 'Cleveland Select'*)-upright pyramidal form much narrower than Bradford. Abundant white flowers. Glossy green foliage. Purple, reddish-orange fall color. Good for street tree plantings. Often referred to as the 'Chanticleer'. Height 25-30' Spread 15-20' (zone 5-8)

Pear, Redspire (*Pyrus calleryana* 'Red Spire')-Dense, pyramidal form. Large white flowers. Glossy green foliage. Yellow to red fall color. Very adaptable to city conditions. Height 30-35' Spread 20-30' (zone 5-8)

Peashrub, Siberian (*Caragana arborescens pendula*)-Extremely cold hardy interesting ornamental. Top grafted weeper. Light green leaf. Bright yellow flowers early to mid-May on previous year's wood. Adapts to containers and small spaces. Tolerates dry, alkaline soils. Height 8-10' Spread 6-8' (zone 2-7)

Plum, Newport (*Prunus* 'Newport')-upright spreading, broadly oval. Single light pink blooms. Purplish-red foliage. Vigorous and cold hardy. Sparse fruit. Probably the hardiest of the purple leafed varieties. Good for street tree plantings. Height 8 Spread 15-20' (zone 3-8)

Plum, Thundercloud (*Prunus* 'Thundercloud')- upright spreading rounded form. Fragrant, single, soft pink blooms. Deep purple foliage through the summer. Sparse fruit. One of the best purple leaf plums, often used in urban street plantings. Height 8 Spread 20' (zone 5-8)

Redbud, Eastern (*Cercis canadensis*)-Small, irregular tree with ascending branches and open form. Reddish-purple buds, open to purple-pink blooms. One of the earliest bloomers. Flowers often produce on old trunks. Seed pods are 3" long and flat. Heart shaped leaves. Yellow fall color. Adapts well to acidic or alkaline soils. Full sun to part shade. Height 20-30' Spread 20-25' (zone 4-9)

Syringa (Japanese Lilac Tree), Ivory Silk (*Syringa reticulata*)- Compact, round, dense form. Deep green foliage. Heavy white blooms mid summer. Drought resistant. Height 20-25' Spread 15' (zone 3-8)

Tulip Tree (*Liriodendron tulipifera*)- Spreading, rising branches, forming tall pyramidal crown. Large, magnificent tree when fully developed. Greenish-yellow flowers appear in May. Large green leaves change to golden yellow in fall. Height 30-40' Spread 30-40' (zone 4-8)
