Shade Trees for Southwest Idaho

Ash, Autumn Purple (*Fraxinus Americana* cv. 'Juniginer')- Rounded, upright form. Glossy green leaves turn reddish-purple in early fall. Fast growing. Prefers full sun. Seedless. Height 60-70' Spread 30-40' (zone 4-8)

Ash, Cinnamon (*Fraxinus pennsylvanica* cv. 'Cinnzam')- Upright oval. Superior new seedless cultivar. Fast growing. Strong, straight central leader. Rich green foliage turns to deep burgundy, changing again to orange-red in fall. Salt tolerant. Height 50-60' Spread 25-30' (zone 4-7)

Ash, Patmore (*Fraxinus pennsylvanica* 'Patmore')- Seedless ash with shiny leaves. Narrow width. Very hardy as well as tolerant of different growing conditions and urban setting. More uniform and symmetrical than Marshall. Yellow fall color. Height 50-60' Spread 30-35' (zone 2-7)

Ash, Summit (*Fraxinus pennsylvanica* 'Summit')- Upright, oval form. Strong central leader. Medium green leaves. Excellent green ash cultivar. Straight central leader. Golden yellow fall color. Drops leaves two weeks earlier than Marshall. Seedless. Height 45' Spread 25' (zone 3-7)

Ash, Windy City (*Fraxinus Americana* 'Windy City') Pyramidal to oval crown. Deep green in summer and beautiful shades of maroon and purple in the fall. Prefers moist, well drained soil. Medium growth rate. Height 50-60' Spread 30-40' (zone 4-8)

Honeylocust, Imperial (*Gleditsia tria. Inermis* cv. 'Impcole')- Uniform, rounded, compact form. Excellent branching habit. Fine textured foliage. Yellow fall color. Thornless and seedless. Full sun. Height 40-50' Spread 20-30' (zone 4-7)

Honeylocust, Shademaster (*Gleditsia tria. Inermis* 'Shademaster')- Wide spreading, symmetrical form. Heavy dark green foliage turns yellow in fall. Thornless and seedless. A rapid grower with a strong straight trunk. Full sun. Height 50-60' Spread 30-35' (zone 4-7)

Honeylocust, Sunburst (*Gleditsia tria. Inermis* cv. 'Suncole')- Broad, pyramidal form. Symmetrical head. Medium growth rate. Golden foliage during spring and early summer changing to lime-green. Heavy pruning maintains new golden leaves. Yellow fall color. Seedless and thornless. Full sun. Height 30-40' Spread 20-35' (zone 4-7)

Linden, Greenspire (*Tilia cordata* 'Greenspire')- Dense, narrow, oval form. Small fragrant flowers in June-July. Strong, uniform upright habit. Extremely straight trunk and central leader. Fast growing. Cinnamon colored bark. Yellow fall color. Widely used street tree. Does well in difficult conditions. Height 40-50' Spread 15-25' (zone 3-8)

Linden, Little Leaf (*Tilia cordata* 'Littleleaf')- Dense pyramidal to broadly round form. Small yellow fragrant flowers. Globose nutlet fruit. Leaves dark green with silver underside. Yellow fall color. Pollution tolerant and pH adaptable. Height 40-50' Spread 25-30' (zone 3-7)

London Planetree, Bloodgood (*Platanus x acerifolia*)- Wide spreading, open form. Medium to dark green foliage. Exfoliating bark. Rapid growing. Tolerates soil compaction, heat and drought. Height 50-80' Spread 30-40' (zone 4-8)

Maple, Autumn Blaze (*Acer x freemanii* cv. 'Jeffersred')- upright oval form. This silver red-cross grows in the higher alkaline soils than rubrums will. It has all the vigor of a silver maple with a slightly smaller leaf, but not the narrow branch angles that cause wind breakage. Its brilliant orange-red fall color is borrowed from the rubrum parents, making this new cultivar one of the best. Height 40-50' Spread 40' (zone 3-7)

Maple, Autumn Flame (*Acer rubrum* 'Autumn Flame')- Dense rounded form. Small leaves are a unique feature of this cultivar. Dependable early red fall color. Branches readily as a juvenile tree. Very hardy. Height 40-50' Spread 40' (zone 3-7)

Maple, Autumn Radiance (*Acer rubrum* 'Autumn Radiance')- Open rounded form. Best of its October Glory and Red Sunset parents with consistent red coloring throughout the tree two weeks earlier in the fall. Lower branching structure is equally as strong as the terminal, causing a more balanced rounded head. Height 30-60' Spread 40' (zone 4-7)

Maple, Crimson King (*Acer platanoides* 'Crimson King')- Dense, rounded form. Maroon foliage all summer. Yellow flowers. Moderate growth rate, producing dense shade. The most popular of all red-leafed Norways. Full sun. Height 40-50' Spread 35-45' (zone 4-7)

Maple, Deborah (*Acer platanoides* 'Deborah')- New foliage is bright red, turning to a vivid dark green. Vigorous grower with a straight central leader. Evenly branched crown. Good for avenues. Form is broadly oval to round. Height 50-60' Spread 40-50' (zone 3-7)

Maple, Emerald Lustre (*Acer platanoides* cv. 'pond')- Broad oval form. Deep green glossy leaves. Selected for its vigorous, prolific branching as a young tree. Yellow fall color. Height 60' Spread 50-60' (zone 3-7)

Maple, Emerald Queen (*Acer platanoides* 'Emerald Queen')- Dense, broad uniform growth habit. New leaves are light pink turning to dark glossy green foliage. Fast growing. One of the finest Norway cultivars for landscape shade and one of the most widely used. Full sun. Height 50' Spread 40' (zone 3-7)

Maple, October Glory Red (*Acer rubrum* 'October Glory')- Dense, rounded form. Medium green, glossy foliage brilliant red in fall. Colors change with weather conditions. Holds leaves late for extended color. A favorite rubrum cultivar due to fall color display. Height 50-60' Spread 40' (zone 4-8)

Maple, Red Sunset (*Acer rubrum* cv. 'Franksred')- Brilliant orange-red fall colors. Rapid growing, upright-spreading in youth, developing to a rounded outline at maturity. Height 40-50' Spread 35-40' (Zone 4-7)

Maple, Sensation Boxelder (*Acer negundo*)-Rounded habit. More controlled and better branching structure than species. Brilliant red fall color. Seedless. Height 60' Spread 35' (Zone 2-7)

Maple, Superform (*Acer platanoides* 'Superform')- Rapid growing, exceptionally straight and symmetrical. Heavy with dark green leaves. Yellow fall color. Reportedly frost crack resistant. Height 50-55' Spread 40-50' (Zone 3-7)

Oak, English (*Quercus robur*)- Deep furrowed, gray-black bark. Leaves are dark green to blue green, small and bluntly lobed. Yellow brown fall color. 1" long acorns. Very adaptable. Prefers well drained soil and full sun. pH tolerant. Good for parks and estate plantings. Height and Spread 40-60' (Zone 4-8)

Oak, Northern Pin (*Quercus ellipsoidalis*)- Oval form. Very slow growing. Fuzzy pin new leaves turn to glossy, bright green through summer. Fall color is scarlet red. Elliptic, chestnut brown acorns. Salt, drought and heat resistant but intolerant of flooding conditions. Native to alkaline soils. Height 50-75' Spread 30-40' (Zone 4-7)

Oak, Northern Red (*Quercus borealis*)- Broad rounded head. Rapid grower. New leaves and leaf stalks are deep red in spring. Large, oval shaped, deeply lobed leaves turn dark red in fall. Pollution and salt resistant. Transplants relatively easy due to negligible taproot. Height 50-60' Spread 30-40' (Zone 4-8)

Oak, Scarlet (*Quercus coccinea*) upright spreading, open, broadly oval form. Growth habit is similar to Pin Oak when young, but becomes more rounded and open at maturity. Displays the best and longest period of brilliant scarlet fall color. Height 50-60' Spread 30-40' (Zone 4-9)

Oak, Swamp White (*Quercus bicolor*)- Broad open form. Leaves are dark green and white underneath. Yellow to red fall color. Distinct flaky gray-brown bark. Excellent drought resistant and yet thrives in wet areas. Prefers moist, acidic soils. Easy variety to transplant. Wood is used commercially. Height 50-60' Spread 30-40' (Zone 4-8)

Poplar, Nor Easter (*Populus x Canadensis* 'Nor Easter')- Moderately ovate. Seedless sterile female. Good disease resistance. Fast growing. Good for screens. Stout branches. Yellow fall color. Height 75' Spread 40-50' (Zone 4-8)

Sweetgum, Worpleston (*Liquidambar styraciflua* 'Worpleston')- This cultivar is said to be cold tolerant to -29 degrees F. Pyramidal to oval form. Twigs not corky and bark is smoother than the species. Unique, narrow, deeply lobed leaves are light, glossy green and have consistent fall coloring of apricot orange to purple. Excellent lawn or street tree. Height 40' Spread 25' (Zone 4-9)

Tulip Tree (*Liriodendron tulipifera*)- Spreading, rising branches, forming tall pyramidal crown. Large, magnificent tree when fully developed; not good for small residential property or streets. Greenish-yellow flowers appear in May. Large green leaves change to golden yellow in fall. Recommend trunk wrapping during winter months. Height 60-80' Spread 30-40' (Zone 4-8)

Willow, Corkscrew (*Salix matsudana* 'Tortuosa')- Wide oval shape. Twisted spiral branches. Yellow fall color. Fast growing. Salt tolerant. Height 30-35' Spread 15-20' (zone 4-8)

Willow, Globe (*Salix matsudana* 'umbraculifera')- Compact, round head. Tendency to remain rounded with age. Tolerant of poorer, drier soils. Height and Spread 20' (Zone 5-8)

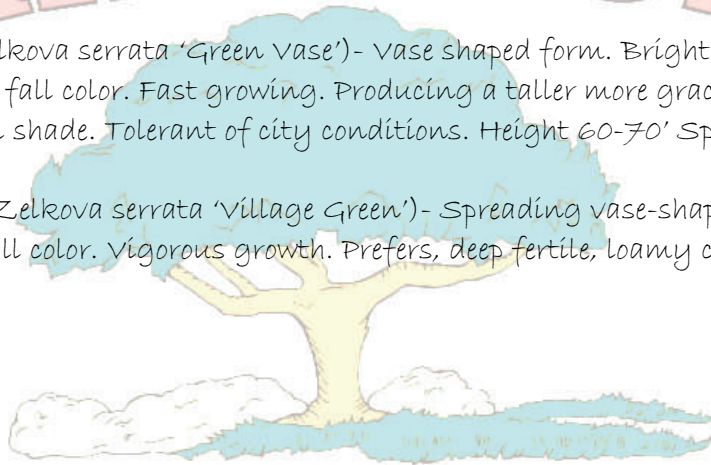
Willow, Green Weeping (*Salix babylonica*)- Broad, rounded head. Dense and weeping. Yellow fall color. Thrives in wet soil conditions. Height 30-50' (zone 4-8)

Willow, Niobe Weeping (*Salix alba* 'Tristis') Rounded head. Weeping form, yellow bark on young branches. One of the first to leaf out and last to drop leaves. Yellow fall color. Fast growing. Very hardy and attractive. Salt tolerant. Height 50-70' Spread 20-30' (zone 3-9)

Willow, Prairie Cascade (*Salix* x 'Prairie Cascade') Hardy cross with glossy green foliage and weeping yellow branches. This variety has the hardiness and glossy green foliage of the Laurel Willow while inheriting the golden bark and weeping have of the Niobe. Height and Spread 35-45' (zone 3-8)

Zelkova, Green Vase (*Zelkova serrata* 'Green Vase')- Vase shaped form. Bright green serrated foliage. Orange-brown to bronze-red fall color. Fast growing. Producing a taller more graceful tree than the 'Village Green'. Full sun to partial shade. Tolerant of city conditions. Height 60-70' Spread 40-50' (zone 4-8)

Zelkova, Village Green (*Zelkova serrata* 'Village Green')- Spreading vase-shaped form. Dark green serrated leaves. Rusty red fall color. Vigorous growth. Prefers, deep fertile, loamy conditions. Height 50-60' Spread 25-30' (zone 4-8)
